

**ORDINANCE TO AMEND CITY OF KEEGO HARBOR MUNICIPAL CODE**  
**Ordinance No. 411**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING FOOD AND BEVERAGE SALES ON  
WATERWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF KEEGO HARBOR**

THE CITY OF KEEGO HARBOR ORDAINS:

Section 1.01. An ordinance to amend Chapter 13, of the Municipal Code for the City of Keego Harbor, Health and Sanitation to prohibit the sale of outdoor food or beverage services on Waterways in the City. To Amend Sec. 13-31 Findings, shall be amended to read as follows:

The city council finds and declares that the interests of public health, Safety and welfare of the citizens of the city require the regulation, Prohibition, licensing and control of assemblages of large numbers of people in excess of those normally drawing upon the health, sanitation, fire, police, transportation, and utility and other public services regularly provided in this city or upon the waterways of this city.

Section 2:01. Sec. 13-32 Definitions shall be amended to read as follows:

Waterways within the city means waters of Dollar Bay, Cass Lake and Sylvan Lake within the City of Keego Harbor.

Section 3:01. Sec. 13-96 Violations shall be amended to read as follows:

(7) That the sale of any food or beverage will be prohibited upon any waterway within the City of Keego Harbor.

Section 4.01. Penalty Clause

Any person(s) who violates this ordinance shall be responsible for a Municipal Civil Infraction as defined in Section 1-7 of the City of Keego Harbor Code.

Section 4:01. Severability

The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Section 5:01. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after approval and publication in a newspaper, general circulation, by the City of Keego Harbor.
