## ORDINANCE NO. 450

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CITY OF KEEGO HARBOR MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 15, OFFENSES ARTICLE VI, OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC SAFETY, SECTION 15.207, FIREWORKS, IN ORDER TO INCORPORATE CHANGES TO STATE LAW REGARDING FIREWORKS AND TO CONFORM THAT IGNITION AND DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS IS NOT PERMITTED EXCEPT ON CERTAIN DAYS AND RESTRICTED TO CERTAIN HOURS.**

THE CITY OF KEEGO HARBOR ORDAINS:

### **Section 1:01.**

That Chapter 15, Offenses, Article VI, Offenses Against Public Safety, Section 15.207, Fireworks, is hereby amended to read as follows:

### **Section 15.207. Fireworks.**

#### **(b) General prohibition on ignition, discharge, and use of consumer fireworks; exception**

- (2) Consumer fireworks may be discharged only on the day before, the day of, and the day after, a National holiday. The (ignition, discharge or use of consumer Fireworks) is prohibited on national Holidays between the hours of 12:00 Midnight and 8:00 a.m. except on New Year's Day when (ignition, discharge or use of consumer fireworks) is prohibited between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.

### **Section 2:01. Repealer.**

Any and all Ordinances and resolutions heretofore adopted inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that the provisions thereof are inconsistent with the provisions hereof, including the prior ordinance provisions of the City adopting the 2003 Edition of the International Fire Code and appendices thereto.

### **Section 3:01. Severability.**

If anyone (1) or more provisions of this Ordinance shall ever be held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions hereof shall nevertheless be continued in full force and effect, it being expressly recited and declared that such remaining provisions would have been enacted despite the invalidity of such provision or provisions so held to be invalid.

**Section 4:01. Savings.**

All proceedings pending and all rights and liabilities existing, acquired, or incurred at the time this ordinance takes effect are saved and may be consummated according to the law in force when they were commenced.

**Section 5:01. Effective Date.**

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby ordered to take effect ten (10) days after adoption by the Keego Harbor City Council.

**Section 6:01. Enactment.**

This Ordinance is declared to have been enacted by the City Council of the City of Keego Harbor at its meeting duly called and held on the 20th day of June, 2013, and shall be given publication in accordance with applicable law.
