I recently sent you a letter informing your office that staff from the Oakland County Animal Shelter and Pet Adoption Center (OCAS/PAC) would soon begin our annual dog census. In that letter, we respectfully asked that you notify your community residents and prepare for the sale of the licenses.

Starting approximately August 15th, 2019 OCAS/PAC Census team workers will begin going door to door in your community to verify compliance with the Michigan State Dog Law of 1919 that requires all dogs to have a valid dog license. This law was enacted to ensure that all dogs have current rabies vaccinations. We vigorously enforce the law as part of our pledge to fortify the public safety.

The census workers will be driving marked county vehicles and will be wearing county shirts with proper identification.

Please notify your staff that we will be in your community beginning approximately August 15th.
