### **NEW BUSINESS**

• Public Hearing perimeter lighting sign ordinance text amendment

Planner Sabo read the following out loud.

The proposed Outline Tubing Section 14.07 proposed amendments are here:

Outline Tubing (Neon) Perimeter Outline Lighting or Tubing (Neon, LED, or similar illumination)

- a. Outline Tubing signs may be permitted by the Planning Commission subject to the following:
- 1. May be used to provide back lighting where the neon **perimeter outline** tubing is fully obscured by opaque lettering or characters;
- 2. Outline tubing may be permitted where the proposed sign is in character with the type of use;
- 3. Outline tubing may be permitted where the proposed sign has significant historical references;
- 4. May not be used to outline the perimeter of a **storefront display** window, **doorway**, **sign**, **or any other similar entry feature**, **window**, **or sign**.

Planner Sabo and the Planning Commission discussed amendments to section 14.07. First, Perimeter Outline Lighting or Tubing (Neon, LED, or similar

illumination) instead of starting with Outline Tubing. Second, is to add 5, restrict lighting only to the hours that the business is open.

Open to the Public for Comment: John Newberry, 1723 Beechcroft, how does this effect existing business's already out?

Planner Sabo stated Council needs to clarify regulations and be more specific going forward. Use the definition of a sign when talking to the current businesses. Manager Voll indicated letters were sent out to existing property owners and business owners regarding the signage and lighting. Complaints were received from residents. The letters have a compliance date, it not complied by that date, a ticket will be issued by the Code Enforcement Officer.

The next step is to have City Council approve the amendments added tonight.
